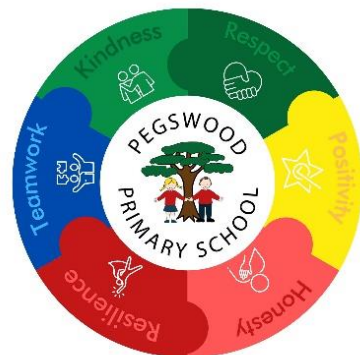


Spring 2nd Half Term 2025

<p>Year 3</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">★ In maths, we will continue to work on fractions, which will include comparing and ordering fractions; understanding the difference between unit fractions and non-unit fractions; interpreting number lines with fractions, and finding equivalent fractions.★ In English, we will be analysing and identifying the key features of non-chronological reports. We will learn different grammatical techniques to make our writing both exciting and informative. This will include using adverbs, commas in lists, conjunctions and expanded noun phrases. Applying knowledge from our history topic, we will write our own informative leaflets about prehistoric creatures.★ In science, we will begin our unit on plants. We will be identifying and labelling the different parts of plants, learning about the root systems of plants, understanding how plants reproduce, and how seeds are dispersed.★ In history, we will be beginning our Stone Age topic. We will look at what life might have been like in the Stone Age period. This will include learning about food, tools and housing of that time. We will also investigate the differences between the Stone Age, Iron Age and Bronze Age.★ Our art unit will link to our science unit. We will be continuing to develop skills in drawing and shading through creating our own botanical artworks.
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
